WHEREAS, Patrick Javier Thompson was much admired and highly respected as an educator who would go the extra mile in service to his students; and


WHEREAS, Patrick Javier Thompson was indeed an energetic, innovative, and loving husband, father, friend and Normalite who always offered both help and humor ...
