

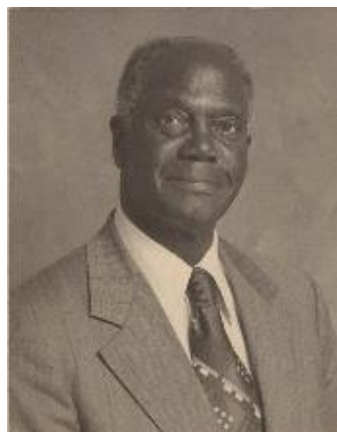
## V. Murray Chambers Building

The V. Murray Chambers Building opened circa 1998. The four-story, brick structure is located at the center of campus originally housed the School of Arts & Sciences, and the departments of Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics. The building current houses the AAMU NSF RISE Program, as well as the departments of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.



The building was named after Dr. Vivian Murray Chambers, Alabama A&M University's first doctoral teacher and long-time member of the faculty, who passed away in 1984.
