

Agribition Center



The Agribition Center was one of two projects developed from the School of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, in conjunction with the Madison County Commission and the local Cattlemen Association. This facility, constructed in 2004 for \$2.5 million, is located south east of the campus-proper at Chase and Moore's Mill Roads.

The facility boasts a 2,000-seat show arena, animal support structures and enclosures for animal science and Cooperative Extension education programs. There are also meeting rooms for educational seminars, workshops and
